- You may have a bloated sensation and pass large amounts of gas.
- If you have any of the following occur, please contact your surgeon:
  - o Chills or fever over 101°.
  - Severe pain not relieved by medication.
  - o Persistent or heavy rectal bleeding other than what was described by your surgeon.
- The surgeon's clinic will notify you when and if you need to repeat your exam.
- If you had any biopsies taken or polyps removed you will receive a letter from the surgeon's office regarding the pathology results in a few weeks. You may call the surgeon's office at 712-262-6320 after two weeks to check your results.
